



Anna Horolets is Assistant Professor at the Institute of Ethnology and Cultural Anthropology, University of Warsaw. With a background in linguistics, sociology and anthropology, she studied the cultural aspects of Europeanization in Poland as well as the role of tourist practices in the systemic transformation. The latter resulted in a monograph (2013) on niche tourism from Poland to the countries of the former Soviet Union. Her current research is on migrants' leisure. Anna Horolets conducted fieldwork on the issue in the US, UK and Poland and is particularly interested in how leisure practices are interdependent with the ideas of the good life in the migratory situation.
