



Aleksander Manterys is Full Professor of Sociology at the Institute of Political Studies of the Polish Academy of Sciences. His main areas of interest are sociological theory and microsociology. His publications include *The Multiplicity of Realities in Social Theories* (Warsaw 1997; in Polish), *The Classical Idea of Definition of the Situation* (Warsaw 2000; in Polish), and *Social Situations* (Cracow 2008; in Polish). He is the co-editor of *New Perspectives of Sociological Theory* (with Janusz Mucha, Cracow 2009; in Polish) and *Individuals and Their Social Contexts* (with Bogdan W. Mach and Ireneusz Sadowski, Warsaw 2018), and the editor of the Polish editions of works of Herbert Blumer, Talcott Parsons, Alfred Schütz and Jonathan H. Turner. He is currently working on the book *Impression Managers: Cooley's Paradigm*.
